Instructions for Attaching Banners to Poles

Here are some simple steps on how to attach your Public Square Rosary Banner to a pole. A banner firmly secured to a pole gives your rally a professional appearance, plus it is much easier to hold.

To do this you will need two 5-foot sections of pvc pipe, 1 ½ inches in diameter, plus 12 feet of industrial self-adhesive velcro. Commercial grade ensures that the wind will not cause the strips to separate. Many hardware stores will cut the pipe to the correct length for you, usually free of charge. These supplies can usually be found at any hardware store.

Step #1: Clean surfaces of the pole and banner and let them dry. (Fig. 1)

Step #2: Measure and then cut the Velcro to the correct lengths
(3 feet). Do not remove backing until step 3.

Step #3: Attach Velcro to the banner and pole ensuring that the Velcro
attached to the pole is the opposite type to that which is on the
banner. Once attached, press the Velcro against the surface so that it
will bond better. (Fig. 2 and 3)

Step #4: Attach the banner to the pole and then you are all set to
have your rally for Our Lady. (Fig. 4)

Step #5: For storage or transport, roll the banner still attached, towards the middle with the message on the inside so it is protected from dirt etc. when not in use. Secure with a rubber band.
